

Net Effect of Taxation for CPI on Existing Property Taxpayers	4.92%	\$ 242,905
Other Core Inc./Dec. +/-% (as proposed today)	0.71%	\$35,000
Core Revenue Increases	-3.03%	-\$149,708
Infrastructure Replacement Reserve Funding	0.61%	\$ 30,000
Net Increase for Municipal Operational Purposes	3.21%	\$ 315,645
Municipal Police Tax – RCMP Increases	1.22%	\$ 60,000
Total Net Increase for Municipal Operations & Policing	4.42%	\$ 249,757

December 13<sup>th</sup> Presentation was 5.06%, a 0.64% decrease.



#### 2023 Proposed Municipal Tax Increase


(Exclusive of all other jurisdictional taxes and using 2022 assessed Value)
